

Halloween Parade Street Closures – Tuesday, October 31st

The Halloween Parade starts right here in Hudson Square! While the parade doesn't officially start till after 6pm, many of our streets will be affected much earlier in the day. See below for Street closures, subway access, and a map.

Summary:

10am	<i>Dominick Street closed (6-V)</i> <i>CitiBike stations at both Spring Street Park and Duarte Square will be locked beginning around 10am on Halloween until the following day. Commuters will not be able to dock bikes at either of these locations/nor will bikes be available for pick up. If you commute using CitiBike we recommend you find alternative locations and arrive early.</i>
Noon	<i>Spring Street closed (6-V)</i>
1pm	<i>Dominick – Broome Street closed (6-V)</i>
5:45pm	<i>All streets closed between Houston to Canal</i> <i>Exceptions: Houston for emergency vehicles</i> <i>Watts for busses (NYPD says busses are ok, parade says no)</i>
6:00pm	<i>Parade route closed (Canal to 16th St.) – NO CROSS TOWN TRAFFIC ALLOWED THRU UNTIL 9:30 PM</i>
C/E Subway	<i>After 5:45 there will be limited access to the C/E trains at Spring Street. Pedestrians will not be able at Spring St. to cross 6th Avenue (east/west). From previous years, we recommend accessing the A/C/E at Canal St. or crossing at Houston Street for the West 4th Street station before <u>4pm</u> to avoid the crowds.</i>

Street Closures

10am	Dominick Street between Varick + Little 6 th Avenue closes Little 6 th Avenue between Spring + Broome Streets closes Parking lanes on Spring Street between Varick + 6 th Avenue unavailable for public use
12:00	M21 Crosstown bus on Spring Street is re-routed off Spring Street No deliveries along Spring Street after Noon
1pm	East side of Varick (Parking lane) between Spring + Dominick Streets unavailable for public use (reserved for hotel guests/car services) Broome Street between Varick + Little 6 th Avenue closes

Spring Street between Varick + 6th Avenue closes

1:30pm Traffic allowed to turn left from Varick onto Broome (against traffic/adjacent to construction)

5:45pm 6th avenue closed to all vehicles beginning at Canal Street running north
No vehicles allowed to cross 6th avenue E/W from Canal Street to 16th Street
No pedestrian crossing 6th avenue E/W Canal to Houston EXCEPT at Charlton Street

C/E Subway access after 5pm

We recommend avoiding the C/E Spring Street station after 4pm if possible

Downtown/ Spring Street station

- Spring Street – ENTRY ONLY
- Vandam Street – EXIT ONLY

Uptown/ Spring Street Station at Spring Street has been designated as – EXIT ONLY

- Entry on the DOWNTOWN side (Spring Street – use the underpass to access uptown service)

Or use the Canal Street station to access both uptown and downtown trains

6pm Pedestrians will be directed to the Canal Street station
