

Hudson Square Mobility Report Q4 2024




Counting Locations


As part of our mission to make Hudson Square a place for people, the Hudson Square BID measures pedestrian movement, subway ridership, and Citi Bike usage throughout our neighborhood to better understand how people travel to and within Hudson Square. Based on our 2023 Workforce Survey, over three-fourths of Hudson Square workers commute to the neighborhood by subway, and with HSBID's new Quarterly Mobility Report featuring district-wide data, we continue to track how our neighborhood moves. Additionally, we have started tracking pedestrian movement at two critical intersections in the district and conducted an analysis of our open spaces in the warm season, to understand the pulse of our neighborhood. Our counting locations are mapped below.


Pedestrian Activity

*Based on estimate of northwest corner due to contstruction


Subway Ridership



Subway ridership has been rising over the past year. This quarter, Monday and Friday commutes have increased, flattening the work-week curve. Q4 data also shows a 26% year-over-year increase in weekend ridership.

^{*}Note: Ridership on Thursday exceeds that of Wednesday by a margin of 250 individuals.

Bike Share Usage



Citi Bike ridership in Hudson Square has been growing continuously through the year of 2024. October of Q4 saw similar numbers to September with over 60,000 total monthly rides across our five stations.
