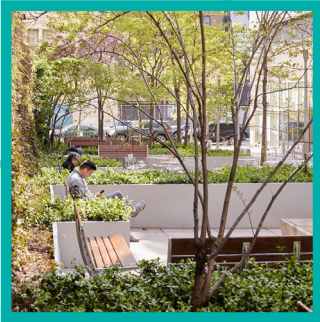

The **BID's** mission in part is to create outdoor spaces where people can mix and mingle while enjoying the sights and sounds, and the food and drink the neighborhood has to offer.



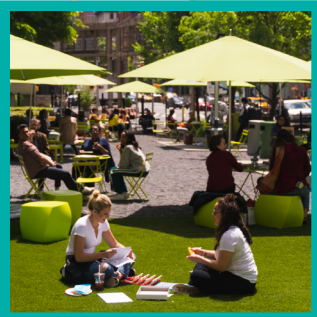

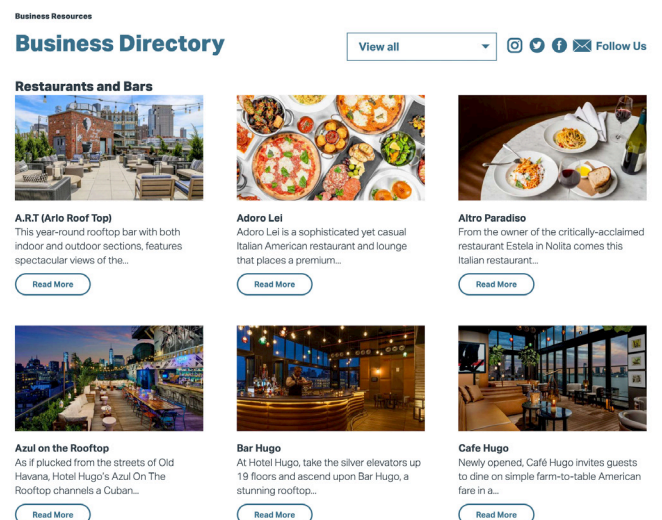

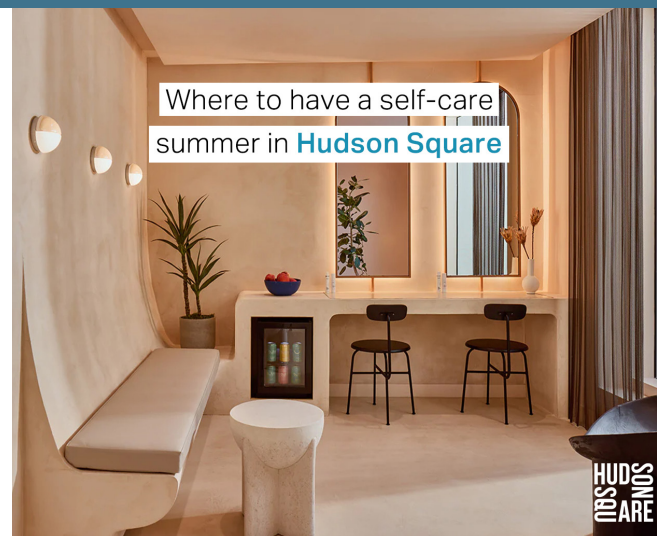

ABOUT THE BID

Since 2009, the Hudson Square Business Improvement District (BID) has served the area generally bounded by Clarkson Street on the north, Canal Street on the south, 6th Avenue on the east, and West Street on the west. Originally created as the City's only planning BID, it has overseen the transformation of Manhattan's former Printing District into a thriving creative hub with inviting open green spaces, abundant public art, vibrant retail and dining, and a growing residential community.

Hudson Square BID's signature projects include the nationally-recognized redevelopment of Hudson Street from Canal to Houston; the creation of new open spaces such as Spring Street Park and Freeman Plazas East and West; an award-winning urban forestry program; pedestrian safety managers; neighborhood maintenance and marketing. The BID's new neighborhood plan builds on lessons learned about open space and mobility, and focuses on seamlessly connecting Hudson Square into surrounding neighborhoods and Hudson River Park.
